Free Run Policy

Purpose:

To define guidelines for use of Free Run Certificates presented to individuals for service they have provided the Bryan-College Station Retriever Club.

Definition:

A Free Run Certificate is a non-tendered document that allows the holder to present it for one entry to one stake at any Bryan-College Station Retriever Club sponsored test.

Conditions:

Individuals are eligible for a free run if:

- 1) Volunteer for 2 days at any one Hunt Test event
 - A) It is the individual's responsibility to sign the volunteer book while at the hunt test event.
(Free runs will be allocated based on the volunteer book provided at each test and audited by the hunt test secretary. Any disputes concerning eligibility of free runs will be arbitrated by the board of directors.)
 - B) A day of volunteer work is considered a minimum of 8 hours on site
 - C) Adult volunteers who are active club members are eligible
- 2) Judge a stake at a Bryan College Station Hunt Test event

BCSRC Members may exchange one free run per Hunt Test for one wingspan worth of raffle tickets. The tickets are only valid the weekend of the event they were issued.

Free run Certificates have no expiration date. Free runs are non-transferable. Free Runs must be presented to the Hunt test Secretary for reimbursement after the individual has processed their own entry for a specific test The HT Secretary will then forward Free runs to the Club Treasurer for reimbursement (Fees charged by Hunt Test Management system are not reimbursed).
