

# BCSRC Board Meeting Minutes

## July 18, 2000

Board Members Present: Wayne Bumgarner, Rody Best, Cary Beason, Dalene Barnes, James Newport, Warren Jatzlau, Rick Littleton, Dave Brannon, Rob McDaniel

The meeting was called to order by President Wayne Bumgarner at 6:30pm in the Brazos County Sheriff's meeting room inside the Post Oak Mall.

Dalene gave a report on the status of the Steve Riggins "bad checks". She advised that the paperwork was being filed with Riggins bank so when the money was in his account it would be withdrawn and paid to us.

The Board discussed the possibility of making our Spring UKC Test a two day event. The points in favor of a two day test were:

- 1) UKC making a Started title and requiring 4 passes.
- 2) More people likely to make the trip for a two day test
- 3) The test ground would already be set up for the second day
- 4) The possibility of making more money

The points not in favor of the two day test were:

- 1) More people need to run the test
- 2) Club members may not want to run a two day test
- 3) Some added expense for the second day

The issue was tabled, pending the availability of the test grounds. Rody is going to check and see if the land owner will let the club use the grounds for 2 days.

The Board discussed getting a trailer to carry the club's test equipment to and from hunt test and training days. After much discussion it was decided to have several Board members go look at a fully enclosed trailer at J&M Trailer on W. Hwy21 in Bryan. A price limit was set at \$2000.00 to be paid for the trailer. Wayne, Rob, Cary, and Rody volunteered to go and inspect the trailer.

The committee assigned to review the club's by-laws passed out proposed changes to the club's by-laws. The proposed changes were discussed. It was decided to present the changes to the club members for a vote on the changes.

The board meeting was adjourned.
